As the COVID-19 situation continues to unfold, the Hamilton County School District will be making adjustments to normal business operations as needed to protect the health of staff and students. With the number of positive COVID-19 cases increasing, the district must take additional precautions to meet the challenges of these difficult times. As a result of a review of the most recent information, the school district will begin full virtual operations on Monday, March 30th. All district offices and facilities will be closed to the public but services will be accessible virtually. This will continue until at least April 14th or until a directive is given to return students to the campus.
