Grades 6-12	Instructors in these grade levels will require access to student laptops and a
	projector. The Apex online learning management system will serve as the
	primary platform for delivering instruction in regards to prevention of the abuse
	and addiction to alcohol, nicotine, and drugs. Also, due to the increase in e-
	cigarette related cases among today's youth, an additional presentation shared
	by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) along with "Know the
	Law" materials will be utilized by our School Resource Deputies to better
	educate adolescents on the health risks associated with these products.
